PART 4: THE HAUNTING (How the Ghost Appears)
When does the ghost first appear? (Christmas Eve at midnight? During a family dinner? While the character is alone by the fire? At a grave? In a dream?)
How do they appear? (Choose the mood you want) □ Fully visible, looks alive at first □ Translucent, clearly a spirit □ Only a voice or presence □ In mirrors or reflections □ Through objects (moving things, leaving signs) □ In a vision or dream □ Felt but not seen

PART 5: THE MESSAGE (What the Ghost Shows or Tells) What does the ghost reveal? (A forgotten memory, a truth the character has been avoiding, what others really think of them, the consequences of their actions, a future they're heading toward)
